## 2021 REGISTRATION FEES

Carlingford Netball Club sets its fees each year, incorporating onward fees set by and payable to Netball NSW and the Hills District Netball Association (HDNA).

All players are required to register online for the 2021 Netball season in the age group appropriate to their date of birth via the MyNetball registration system using the email address for previous registrations and password.

To ensure placement in a team, payment is due at the time of registration. We are unable to place players in teams without prior online registration and fee payment.

For the 2021 season, we have brought back the Early Bird fee for the month of January for Net Set Go “Set”, Net Set Go “Net”, Juniors, Cadets and Seniors registrations. From February 1, all of these registration types will be charged an additional \$20. The Net Set Go “Net” – Carlingford Beginners Squad is not subject to an additional fee.

Payment can be made by Visa or Mastercard at the time of online registration. Please note there is a surcharge of 1.78% of the registration fee plus 31c applied to on-line payments to the card provider, not to Carlingford Netball Club.

Carlingford Netball Club is a registered Active Kids Program provider. The [program](#) is for all NSW school children, aged 5 to 18 years. If you would like to redeem your \$100 Active Kids Voucher for your Netball registration, please [claim](#) your voucher with Service NSW prior to registering.

Uniform costs are not included in the registration fee.

- **Net Set Go “Net” – Carlingford Netball Club Beginners Squad** is a 10-week introductory Netball skills and activity program for participants turning 5, 6, 7, 8 & 9 years by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021. The Squad is run in Term 2 on Wednesday afternoons at our club’s home training courts at Don Moore Reserve, Tiernan Avenue North Rocks. This is listed as “Net - Activity/Skills” in the online registration.
- **Net Set Go “Set”** - players turning 6, 7, 8 & 9 years by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021. These players play modified matches on Friday nights at Pennant Hills Park, that emphasize fun, participation and learning the basic skills of netball in a non-competitive (no competition ladder) and safe environment. Team training is held during the week at Don Moore Reserve. This is listed as “Set – Skills/Competition” in the online registration.
- **Net Set Go “Net”** - players turning 9 & 10 by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021. This is the start of competitive Netball and is played on a Saturday Morning at Pennant Hills Park with team training held during the week. This is listed as “Go – Competition” on the online registration.
- **Junior Competition** – players turning 11, 12, 13, 14 & 15 by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021. Junior Competition Netball is held on a Saturday morning at Pennant Hills Park with team training held during the week. This is listed as “Junior” on the online registration.
- **Cadets** - Players turning the ages of 16, 17, 18 by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021 are graded as Cadets. Five players turning 15 years by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021 are also permitted to play in a Cadets team. Cadets Competition is held on a Saturday afternoon at Pennant Hills Park with team training held during the week. This is listed as “Cadet” on the online registration.
- **Senior Registration** - Players turning 18 or over by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021 participate in a Senior Team. Senior Netball is held on a Saturday afternoon at Pennant Hills Park with team training held during the week. This is listed as “Senior” on the online registration.

## **GRADINGS DAY**

Carlingford Netball Club will hold a Grading Day **on Sunday February 28 2021** for our junior age groups (Under 10 to Under 15) where two or more teams are required to be filled. This event will be held at Don Moore Reserve or Muirfield High School. Further details will be provided to all players and parents through our Facebook page, website and E-newsletter closer to the date, however please keep this date clear to ensure attendance on the day.

## **ADDITIONAL REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

**Proof of Age:** may be required for all Net Set Go and Junior players who have not previously registered with Netball NSW/My Netball online registration. New players may be requested to supply Carlingford Netball Club with a certified copy of their Birth Certificate or Passport as part of the Registration process.

**Refund Policy:** If a registered player cannot be placed into a team, a full refund of registration fees will be given. However, if a position on a team is allocated, no refunds can be given unless there are exceptional circumstances (e.g. Doctors certificate, moving out of area etc). Please note that this will be at the discretion of the Club Executive Committee and a \$20 administration fee may also apply. Once monies have been forwarded to Netball NSW no refunds can be given.

## **BEFORE YOU BEGIN REGISTERING**

Before you begin the MyNetball online registration process, you will need your unique MyNetball Login ID and password. (New Players will not have this yet).

Please complete the online registration form on the My Netball site as a parent / guardian if the registering player is under 18 years of age. Contact details provided (i.e. email address and mobile numbers) must be those of the parent.

## **IF YOU ARE A RETURN USER (played for Carlingford or another club in NSW)**

- Step 1. Click the link under 'Registration link\*' above to take you to the MyNetball web site for online registration
- Step 2. You will be taken to a Welcome page where you will need to enter your Login ID and Password.
- Step 3. If you remember your ID number and Password then enter it in the login fields. Your ID may be numerical or it may be your email address (particularly for players that have been registered for a couple of years or longer). **Go to Step 4.**
  - Step 3a. If you have forgotten your password, then select the option for it to be reset – this will go to your last known email address. Follow the prompts to reset your password.
  - Step 3b. If you have forgotten both ID and Password you will need to select the tab "Don't have a login ID"
  - Step 3c. You will need to enter in some basic player information and perform a player search to locate your player ID.
  - Step 3d. Find your most recent registration profile e.g. Carlingford Netball or your previous club if relevant
  - Step 3e. You will be prompted to reset your password to progress to the registration page
  - Step 3f. Once the temporary password has been sent, enter this along with the Login ID, to log into the MyNetball web site. We suggest that you change your temporary password to one you will remember
  - Step 3g. Now enter your login ID and password in the Log-in page.

- Step 4. Continue to the registration page and select the appropriate registration type. This will only allow you to select the age appropriate registration type. E.g. A Cadet cannot register as a junior and vice versa
- Step 5. Complete the required information – note any mandatory fields
- Step 6. Review all entered information to confirm everything is correct.
- Step 7. Ensure terms and conditions have been read and ticked
- Step 8. Continue to payment field. Only credit card payments are acceptable on the MyNetball web site. There is no provision for cash or cheque.

### **IF REGISTERING FOR THE FIRST TIME (never been a member of any netball club in NSW)**

- Step 1. Click under 'Registration link\*' above to take you to the MyNetball web site for online registration.
- Step 2. You will be taken to a Welcome page where you will need to select "don't have a Login ID"
- Step 3. You will need to enter in some basic player information and perform a player search to ensure there is no previous Netball ID or record. Follow the prompts to receive a Login in ID and password
  - Step 3a. Enter the newly found ID number and follow the prompts to reset your password. An email will be sent to your registered email address with a temporary password.
  - Step 3b. Once the temporary password has been sent enter this along with the ID number to log in to the MyNetball web site. It is suggested you immediately change your temporary password to one you will remember
  - Step 3c. Now enter your ID number and password in the Log-in page.
- Step 4. Continue to the registration page and select the appropriate registration type. This will only allow you to select the age appropriate registration type. E.g. A Cadet cannot register as a junior and vice versa
- Step 5. Complete the required information – note any mandatory fields
- Step 6. Review all entered information to confirm everything is correct
- Step 7. Ensure terms and conditions have been read and ticked
- Step 8. Continue to payment field. Only credit card payments are acceptable on the MyNetball web site. There is no provision for cash or cheque.
